Secondment to SMT (1)

Applications are invited for an unremunerated secondment of two academic years to the SMT from September 2010. The specific responsibility attached to the secondment will be the leadership and co-ordination of the School's response to the STEM initiative and for overseeing and monitoring the STEM action plan outlined in the School Development Plan. This should be regarded as a developmental opportunity.

Post Specification

The successful applicant will be required to

- Ensure that the action plan is fully implemented
- Research potential funding for STEM activities
- Attend all meetings of the STEM Development Team
- Liaise with appropriate HoDs where necessary
- Report regularly to SMT
- Prepare the STEM section of the Quarterly Operating Report for the Board of Governors.

Criteria

For the purposes of short-listing, preference may be given to applicants who

- have successfully borne responsibility as part of a whole-school initiative;
- have curricular experience in an area which is directly related to the STEM subjects;
- can demonstrate their ability to work productively and harmoniously with colleagues.

Applicants should write a letter to the Headmaster outlining how they meet the criteria and deliver it to his office by 12 noon on Thursday 9 September 2010.
