Secondment to SMT (2)

Applications are invited for an unremunerated secondment of two academic years to the SMT from September 2010. The specific responsibility attached to the secondment will be the leadership and co-ordination of the School's continuing implementation of the Northern Ireland Curriculum (Revised) reporting to the Academic Vice-Principal and the Senior Teacher with responsibility for the Curriculum. This should be regarded as a developmental opportunity.

Post Specification

The successful applicant will be required to

- ensure that the School is meeting all statutory and regulatory obligations;
- lead and co-ordinate the curricular priority for the year;
- liaise closely with HoDs;
- encourage and co-ordinate the sharing of good practice between departments

Criteria

For the purposes of short-listing, preference may be given to applicants who

- have successfully borne responsibility as part of a whole-school initiative;
- have been involved in general curricular development at a whole-school or departmental level;
- have been actively involved with the implementation of the NI Curriculum either at a whole school or departmental level;
- can demonstrate their ability to work productively and harmoniously with colleagues.

Applicants should write a letter to the Headmaster outlining how they meet the criteria and deliver it to his office by 12 noon on Thursday 9 September 2010.
