

## Year 13 mock examinations

### Week beginning 16<sup>th</sup> January

- During this week, you are only required to be in school when you have an examination.
- Please use time at home wisely, with sessions of short, focused revision, (the bulk of your preparation should already have been done) and regular exercise.
- Be punctual.
- Please come to examinations properly prepared. Make sure you have the required pens, pencils, rulers, protractors etc.
- All the rules and guidelines that have been in place for every set of exams that you have sat still apply. Total quiet during exams. Notes and books should be placed under desks for the duration of the exam (please do not bring bags in unless you have to). Any evidence of cheating will normally result in the paper being awarded zero.
- All examinations will be in the Sixth Form Study room apart from the Mathematics C2 paper on the Friday before the examination sequence starts, the Art examination on 17<sup>th</sup> January and the Drama examination on 20<sup>th</sup> January. These will be in venues as directed by teachers of these subjects.
- Open Night is on the evening of 19<sup>th</sup> January and, although several examinations involving significant numbers of boys take place the next morning, you are expected to be at Open Night if you are needed by members of staff. Please plan for this.
- These examinations are not opportunities for you to clarify how much you **do not** know and understand. It should be taken as read that the necessary preparation and learning have already been done and that the examination provides a means of testing your answering technique under pressure.
